Think about it: you get the relief from the pressure with the physical popping of the pimple. Then, when you get a good one (ew!), there's a sense of satisfaction or victory. In addition, your brain releases that good stuff called dopamine, the happy chemical.

### BUT WHY FOCUS YOUR PICKING AND POPPING **ON YOUR SPOUSE?**

That satisfaction doesn't just apply to popping your own pimples. Spouses may enjoy doing the same for each other, and you can think of it as a way to show affection! A weird way, sure, but it's a sign of love to want to take care of those blemishes for your partner.

#### PREVIOUSLY: DO FACIAL ROLLERS REALLY DO ANYTHING?

Traube says, "As disgusting as it might sound to some, that you would pick your partner's pimples, that does show a certain closeness, a bond, an attachment between you and your partner". We do stuff like that all the time for our kids,
